Q: What is CFRE?

A: CFRE stands for "Certified Fund Raising Executive" and it is the recognized credential as the global standard for fundraising.

Q: How do I become a CFRE?

A: CFRE Certification includes the following 3-Step Process:

Step One: Complete the Online Application Candidates must document a

minimum number of points in three categories (Education, Professional Practice, and Professional

Performance) in order to be approved to take the CFRE examination. Your application must be

approved before you can be scheduled for the CFRE exam.

Step Two: Pass the CFRE Exam CFRE Exam Content includes the following:

- ◊ Current and Prospective Donor Research (28 items 14%)
- ◊ Securing the Gift (46 items 23%)
- ◊ Relationship Building (52 items 26%)
- ◊ Volunteer Involvement (16 items 8%)
- ◊ Leadership and Management (38 items 19%)
- ◊ Ethics, Accountability and Professionalism (20 items 10%)

Step Three: Agreement to uphold a code of ethics and Accountability Standards
